FOREST KINDY TERMS 2 & 3

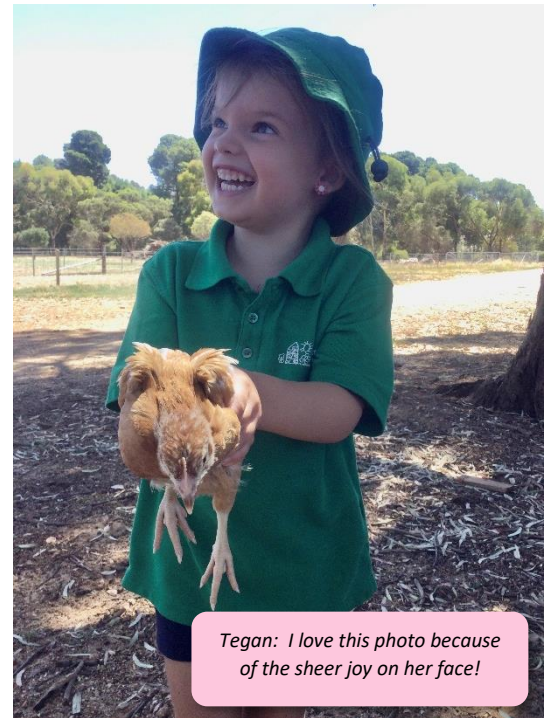
