




Our Philosophy

Our Space

Our Fees

We also have visits from the council to talk to us about sustainability & have had portrait workshops run by the Art Gallery of South Australia. Our excursions this year have also included a nature play excursion to Wittunga Botanic Park & our Hopgood theatre trip to see Beep!



Our Connections with Coorara Primary School

As well as developing a sense of belonging in the Kindy environment, our children have multiple opportu-

nities to connect with the school. These include: library visits, visits from the reception class where we made scarecrows together (which our children named Data) and the Coorara Cubs transition to school program.
