At Governing Council last week we approved the

- Child Care and Preschool Fees Policy, including Child Care Bookings Procedure
- Child Care Waitlist Procedure

These are included with this newsletter. Please note that your regular fee (full fee minus your CCS %) is charged for absences when you cancel after 6pm on the day prior to the booking you are cancelling. If you cancel before 6pm, you will only be charged the 50% holding fee, as this gives us time to adjust our staffing. Full fees are also charged for Public Holidays to cover staff wages.
