

Sustainability practices

The preschool encourages children to be aware of and take care of their environment. We have solar panels, a vegetable garden, butterfly garden and encourage recycling of scraps, paper and deposit containers. At lunch the children are encouraged to sort rubbish into recyclable and non recyclable and fruit scraps which are collected each day, these are available for families to take home and use as compost material or chook food. Our bathroom taps turn off automatically and children are encouraged to use water wisely. The children will learn a lot about environmental practices as part of our curriculum.

Junk Materials

The items below are always in demand by the children for collage and construction. Please save them for us.

- Cardboard boxes
- Bottle tops
- Buttons
- Wool scraps
- Wood off cuts—soft wood is best.
- Material scraps
- Ribbons and lace
- Greeting cards, please cut off the backs
- Rolls, not toilet rolls
- Gift wrap

Please leave these items in the kitchen to allow staff to check for items that may not be suitable eg toilet rolls, medicine boxes, cereal boxes that contain nuts.
