



Excursions and incursions

Once per term, the kindergarten will have an incursion (a guest or event will come to visit us) or an excursion (we will go for a visit). These events are usually covered by the term's fees. This means that there is usually no additional cost for families.

The Department for Education's permission slips and information will be provided for all families to complete and no child will be able to go on an excursion without signed parental/caregiver's permission.

Parents are welcome and encouraged to share this experience however sometimes the excursion will not be suitable for younger siblings like the Road Safety School.

Risk assessments which identify any foreseeable hazards, will be completed and updated

Before any excursion, medical plans, behavioural support and child to staff ratios are also considered to ensure an enjoyable and safe experience for all.

Visits to the community garden next door and walks to childcare have specific permission slips which are to be completed upon enrolment.
