#### Dear families,

The children and educators are feeling more at home, adapting routines to their newly modified environment. The curriculum is in full swing, so we thought you may like to learn a little bit more about what the children are learning. The 0 to 5 year olds curriculum is based on the Early Years Learning framework and the school-aged children on the My Time Our Place framework. These National documents have 5 broad outcomes which the Programmers use as a basis for all learning experiences they plan, which are also based on individual child and group observations. The Programmers are:

Enola- Under 2year olds

**Lisa**– 2 to 3yr olds

Kate-3 to 5 year olds

Jackie & Anna- Kindy

Casey– Out of School Hours Care Nicole– Tuesday Playgroup

Sally-Friday Playgroup

The Programmers display the programs in each of the Primary Caregiving learning spaces for your information. The other educators work as a team to implement the learning experiences to achieve the set goals. These are reported to you through the Floor Books, weekly snapshots, Communication Books and/or on Flexibuzz. A poster with more information is printed on the back.

A vital part of learning in the early years is the interaction and communication between children and adults, so we feel fortunate to have a special event happening the week of **World Book** day. Yasmin and Mary are coming from the Fraser Mustard Centre and Telethon Kids Institute to share hints and tips with parents, carers and educators in 5 vital developmental areas.
