Blakeview Preschool is a stand alone preschool located adjacent to Blakeview Primary School. Blakeview Preschool has a collaborative relationship with Blakeview Primary School which will provide a positive school transition for children.

- Sessional Kindergarten for eligible children- Universal Access provides children with 15 hours per week of preschool. This is provided as 2 full days either Monday/Tuesday or Wednesday/Thursday (8am-3.30pm)
