Curriculum

Kindergartens use the national curriculum document – **Belonging, Being & Becoming.** This is **the Early Years Framework for Australia.**

This curriculum is a guide for thinking about children's learning, for recognising and building on what they know and can do.

Expected learning outcomes for children birth to 5 years are

Children have a strong sense of identity
Children are connected and contribute to their world
Children have a strong sense of well being
Children are confident and involved learners
Children are effective communicators

These outcomes guide our planning and learning. We plan our learning experiences with the children through **Learning Committees**, consisting of one adult and 5 or 6 children. The children's learning ideas include topics, concerns, interests and activities. The children help to set up the activities for this learning in the ensuing fortnight.
