WHAT TO BRING TO PRESCHOOL

Please ensure that all your child's belongings are clearly named

HEALTHY EATING

Our preschool encourages healthy eating, please provide your child with healthy snacks such as fruit, vegetables, yoghurt or cheese and crackers. DO NOT send lollies, chocolate, cordial, flavoured milk, juice and other foods containing large amounts of sugar. Please note we are a nut free zone. Please read the Nutrition Policy and Allergy Aware Policy for further information.

CLOTHING

Please dress your child in appropriate clothing that they can manage by themselves. Clothing should protect them from the sun or keep them warm when the weather is cooler. Children spend time outside all year round and will get wet and dirty during their play so please dress

your child in clothes that you don't mind getting dirty. Please label your child's belongings.

ALLERGIES AND MEDICAL CONDITIONS

It is essential that you notify staff of any allergies / medical conditions that your child may have and provide a care plan which has been signed by a medical professional. Due to health and safety reasons our Preschool is a NUT FREE ZONE, please see the Allergy Aware Policy for further information. All staff are trained in first aid.

ATTENDANCE


Although attendance at Preschool is not compulsory it is in the interests of your child's emotional, social and cognitive development for them to attend Preschool regularly. COLLECTION / DELIVERY OF CHILDREN

Only parents or other authorised adults aged 18 years or over are allowed to collect children from the Preschool. If you have an emergency and are unable to collect your child, then please ring the Preschool to inform staff of the person who will be collecting your child.

PRESCHOOL FEES

- Provide easy to open lunch boxes
- Get your child to practise
 - Putting on their own shoes and socks
 - Putting on sunscreen
 - Taking responsibility for their own belongings
 - Feeding themselves
 - o Encouraging your child to be independent and do things for themselves
