#### Invacuation/Evacuation Procedures

Every term we practice our emergency invacuation and evacuation procedures here at kindy. We learn together how to keep ourselves in a safe group and place in the event of an emergency. We listen for signals, we use the whistle for gathering outside and a gas horn for gathering inside. We use the roll/sign in sheet to call out the names for the children to respond with "Here". We use the roll/sign in sheet as an accurate document to ensure the safety of the children.

Please when you arrive at Kindy, ensure you have signed your child in and on leaving you have signed your child out.

# Collecting your Child from Kindy

The Department for Education Guidelines around the collection of children states that in the event that you are unable to collect your child they may only be collected by

- 1. the authorised persons stated on your child's enrolment form.
- 2. someone you have given written permission for in the diary.
- 3. Verbal authority given over the phone.

# Sunsafe at Kindy


At Kindy we are required to wear a hat during Terms 1,3 and 4 for outside play and if the UV Rays are 3 or higher.


Please send your child with a named sun safe hat (as pictured below)


To keep your children safe at kindy please remove any toggles, drawstrings or cords.

# Child and Family Health Service

On 31<sup>st</sup> March some families will be invited to book a health check for their child. These checks often pick up things that have been previously missed and are a great way to reassure you that your child's development is on track. If you cannot make an appointment please let Corinne know so that we can offer it to someone else.

Child and Youth Health visit us once a term and children are required to be a minimum age of 4 years and 3 months. Children are only required to have one health check per year.

### Frequently asked questions.....

- Please remember to sign your child in and out of Kindy every day. The Roll is located on the table at the entrance. There's also a diary on the table to write in the name of any grandparent/guardian who might pick your child up when you are unable to.
- Please pack 2 pieces of fruit and leave them in your child's Kindy bag for easy access at morning and afternoon snack time.
- Please encourage your child to organise themselves on arrival at kindy by.....
  - -Carrying their own bag
  - -placing their Lunch box in the lunch trolley, and their drink bottle in the drink bottle trolley.
  - -Choosing their own locker.
  - -Making themselves ready for the day ie. Hat on for outside play
- Please name all your child's property including their hats and spare clothes, lunch boxes and drink bottles.

- Please send your child in appropriate play clothes for them to explore our learning environment.
- Please respect our neighbours and protect our families by parking responsibly.
- Please discourage your children from bringing toys etc from home to kindy

   we have a lot of things here for them to play with and if you find any of our resources/equipment in their bags we would love to have it back.
- Child notice pockets are located on the back of the entrance doors.
   Notes from kindy about your child or activities happening at Kindy will be placed in these pockets. Parents to check daily.
- On Fridays please pack a regular lunch box for lunchtime.
- We encourage drinking water from our bottles during the day, promoting this at our morning and afternoon healthy snack times and at lunch time. We have a filtered water tap that the children can access to refill their bottles. This is located near the bathroom door.
