Kindergarten

In Department for Education kindergartens, children are able to access a maximum of 15 hours per week of kindergarten / preschool for four terms prior to starting school. Preschool programs are play-based educational programs, designed and delivered by qualified teachers using the national curriculum framework.

Sessions: Monday to Thursday 8.00am - 3.30pm

Occasional Care

Occasional Care is short term child care for babies, toddlers, and children from 6 months. Care is available for a maximum of one session per week, depending on availability.

Sessions: Tuesday to Thursday

Morning 8:30 - 11:30

Afternoon 12:15 - 3:15

Under 2's available Wednesday mornings only

Please note: Occasional Care is only available to children who do not access any other forms of child care or Family Day Care.
