Celebrating Kurna Language

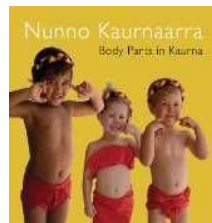
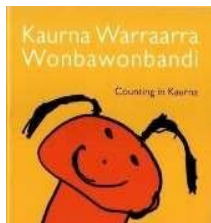
The Kurna language books were first published in 2007 by the Kalaya Children's Centre Management Committee

Incorporated, the governing body of Kalaya which is an integrated early childhood centre in the western suburbs of Adelaide. Kalaya has a proud tradition of Aboriginal early child development and transition into the school system while maintaining identity.



Kurna is the traditional language of the Kurna people, traditional custodians of the Adelaide Plains area in South Australia. Maintaining the language is integral to preserving a unique and precious cultural heritage and relationship to country.

The first book in the series is titled 'Kurna Warraarra Wonbawonbandi-Counting in Kurna', the second is 'Nunno Kurnaarra-Body parts in Kurna', and the third is 'Kuranye Kurnaarra-Colours in Kurna' The fourth book is titled 'Ngaityu Muiyu' My Feelings in Kurna.



The books contain engaging photos of children visually demonstrating each word, be it a number, colour or body part, integrated with vivid, friendly graphic design and imagery. For older children (and others) each word is contextualised within a sentence. The books also contain a spoken word CD to assist with correct pronunciation, as well as song. 'Kurna Warraarra Wonbawonbandi-Counting in Kurna' was narrated by Nelson Varcoe (Uncle Snooky) with both 'Nunno Kurnaarra- Body parts in Kurna' and 'Kuranye Kurnaarra- Colours in Kurna' being narrated by Vincent Jack Kanya Kudnuitya Buckskin. Ngaityu Muiyu has a QR code which takes you an audio file of the book.

These publications are available in a large glossy format (200mm x 200mm) ideal for preschool and primary school aged children as well as anyone else interested in learning Kurna language. The colours book is also available in a durable 'board book' (150mm x 150mm) for children up to the age of two.

Available at just \$15.00 each or \$55.00 for the complete set of four, the Kalaya Management Committee also offer a wholesale price for large orders. The Kurna language books are an invaluable teaching and learning aid. Proceeds from sales of these books fund language and cultural programs at the Kalaya Children's Centre.
