
Dear Parents and Carers.

Welcome back to the last term of 2019. I would also like to take the opportunity to welcome new families commencing at our Centre this term. The term is a short 9 weeks and will be extremely busy as we support children with their transition to school or transition into Preschool for 2020. 
## **Quality Area 1- Educational Program & Practise**

We continue on our literacy journey of exploring focus text through the duration of a term. This term we have selected two text 'Handa's Hen' and 'The Little Red Hen' to support the inquiry in Science of the lifecycles of chickens and the dispositions of teamwork /persistence and the social development of friendship.

In literacy terms, Handa's Hen promotes rhyming, alliteration, vocabulary concepts of location, animal names while the Little Ren Hen promotes vocabulary of animals, tools, food growth/harvest cycle. Both texts support us to continue to build children's expertise in the print concepts including: author, page turning, front/ back cover, letter /words, genre of text, illustrations.



Both text provide opportunities to understand the main characters, the plot and sequence of the story and to integrate this learning into play opportunities.



### Transition to start school in 2020

If your child is enrolled at Lake Windemere B-7 School for next year you will shortly receive information about transition visits and Parent Information meetings. This will be placed in your child's communication pocket.

I can confirm the school transition visits to Lake Windemere B-7 school will occur on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> October 9:00am-11:00am and Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November 9:00am-1:00pm.

If you have not completed school enrolment forms yet we urge you to do this as soon as possible to ensure your child benefits from formal transition visits.

If your child is not attending Lake Windemere B-7 school next year they will come to Preschool on 30/10/19 and 6/11/19 for their usual sessions. We would appreciate if the families of these children could bring written notice of their child's transition visits dates at their chosen school to assist us with our planning. Thank you.

# Transition to start Preschool in 2020

On Wednesday 16th October (week 1 term 4) we will be conducting 2 Parent Information Meetings (9:00am-10:30am and 6:00pm-7:30pm) for families who have children commencing Preschool in 2020. To complete the meetings we will close off half of the Preschool room for the day. We will operate a limited crèche for the families attending the meeting in the Community space. Bookings are essential please see Kim our Receptionist.

All families with children attending their regular preschool sessions for the day will enter the Preschool room from the entrance door near the Reception area.

On Wednesday 30/10/19 our new Preschool children for 2020 will visit the Centre for their first transition visit. Their families will stay with them for the 2 hour session either 9:00am-11:00am or 12:30pm-2:30pm. This will provide an opportunity for staff to connect with each family.

The second transition visit for the new preschool children will be 6/11/19 2 hour session either 8:45am-10:45am or 11:00am-1:00pm. Parents are free to drop off and collect for this second visit.
