Dear Parents and Carers,

On behalf of all staff we wish you a warm welcome to our Centre. For families returning to the Centre again we trust that you have enjoyed relaxing time with family and friends. All staff are keen to work to tailor individualised support for your child's care and education and provide resources and support to you as a family or carer to ensure that you are able to do the important job of parenting. Our 2019 Centre priorities will focus on Reading, Transition and Wellbeing. This will result in an exciting year as staff continue on their professional learning journey.

Better Goodbyes

After a successful trial of Better Goodbyes in the Occasional Care program on Monday mornings terms 3 and 4,2018 we are extending the strategy to Thursday morning Occasional Care and each Preschool session this year.

Better Goodbyes provides a quieter space for families to hand over care of their child to educators. After the goodbye from the family, a staff member remains available in a quiet space: the sleep room for Occasional Care children and the divided preschool indoor space for Preschool children. Occasional Care children can wander from the sleep room when they are ready to explore the wider learning environment and Preschool children can move outdoor when ready. For children who are anxious or struggling with separation, the quieter indoor spaces will provide a dedicated staff member to support them with attachment and emotional regulation.

We look forward to your support and feedback about the new procedure. Please chat to staff if you have any questions.

Focus Teacher

Each preschool child will be allocated a focus teacher for the year. The teachers will introduce themselves to you within the first week of preschool. They will also provide a focus teacher letter explaining their interaction with your child during the year and their planning and assessment responsibilities. Existing Preschool children will continue with their focus teacher from last year.

Parents and Carers are reminded to ensure all children have a sunhat for outdoor play in term 1 as required by the Sunsmart policy. Please ensure they are clearly marked with your child's name. You can purchase a hat from the reception desk or school front office at a cost of \$6:00



We would like to remind every family that children are required to have the following each session:

- Sun cream applied prior to arrival at preschool/Occasional Care/Crèche
- · Appropriate clothing to cover shoulders and tops of arms

 A drink bottle filled with water. Educators will top up drink bottles with filtered water throughout the day as necessary.



Literacy Packs
