Welcome back to Preschool for Term 2. We trust that everyone has had a safe and restful holiday break spent with family and friends. It is such a great time to recharge our bodes ready for another busy term.

Sunscreen:

Yes even though the weather is cooler, sunscreen is still important as we spend long periods of time outside. At Preschool, we use the SunSmart app to keep track of the UV regularly. Just a reminder to please remember to apply sunscreen to your child before Preschool, as this allows the sunscreen time to soak into the skin and be adequate protection from the harsh UV rays. Sunscreen is then reapplied after lunch with the supervision of educators. Educators guide children in applying their sunscreen themselves and it is such a great satisfaction for the children! Next time you are getting ready to apply sunscreen at home, guide your child to apply it themselves just like at Preschool.







Mother's Day Stall:

On Thursday 10th May, Preschool children will have the opportunity to visit the Mother's Day stall and purchase a gift. If you would like your child to participate, please send money up to \$10 in a labelled resealable bag with your child's name and dollar amount. Any change will be placed back into the re-sealable bag and returned. Prices of items usually range from around 50cents - around \$5.

Immunisation Records:

Just a reminder if your child has had any updated vaccinations, please remember to take your child's Blue Book to the school front office so we can keep our records up to date. Please note a record of each vaccination is to be provided to a DECD service for sighting within 2 weeks of the vaccination being administered or when next attending the service (whichever occurs first). Once a child has completed the recommended vaccinations from the childhood schedule (at 3 1/2 - 4 years) no additional immunisation records are required to be sighted.

Child Protection Curriculum:

We enjoyed having Alex O'Loan and the team from Mallala CFS visit us late in term 1 (See more photos on the CFS visit in your child's Profile Folder). This tied in perfectly with our work on Emergencies as part of the CPC. Next we will continue to talk about Emergencies and explore what might constitute an emergency for a child. We will discuss the following scenarios: wet pants, feeling sick, fire, road accident, someone hurting me, getting lost, a dog barking at me in the street and having no fruit at Preschool and feeling hungry.
