TOILET SUPPORT AND NAPPY CHANGING INFORMATION

Rationale:

- At the Manor Farm Kindergarten educators aim to provide a quality teaching and learning environment that is supportive and inclusive of all children.
- Links to National Quality Standards:
 - 2.1.1 Each child's wellbeing and comfort is provided for.
 - 6.1 Respectful relationship with families are developed and maintained and families are supported in their parenting role.

Considerations:

- Children starting preschool DO NOT need to be toilet trained. We are more than happy to support families through the toilet training process.
- The centre has a hydraulic nappy changing table on lease from SERU. We also have a nappy bin service, with weekly bin collections.

Parents will:

- Provide the centre with information on enrolment (or as the need arises) about their child's toilet support requirements.
- Supply the centre with a written **Continence Plan**. This needs to be completed by a treating health professional, such as a Doctor or an Occupational Therapist.
- Provide the centre with a daily supply of items needed to adequately undertake the toileting support eg nappies, pull-ups, wet wipes, change of clothes.

Educators will:

- Follow the toilet training program, as set out in the child's continence plan.
- Complete a nappy changing log, including toilet information form for families.
- Regularly 'touch base' with families to ensure consistency of practice between the two settings.
- Liaise with the Department for Education Special Educator, to negotiate additional support, if required.
