## 3. Curriculum

- A play based curriculum is offered which is guided by the Early Years Learning Framework.
- The Early Years Learning Framework and the Preschool Numeracy and Literacy Indicators underpin our assessment of childrens learning and reporting processes.
- Core Values- Respect, Relationships, Wellbeing, Active learning, Kindness.
- Our program is reflective of the dispositions for learning promoted within the EYLF.
- Intentional teaching and learning experiences based on childrens interests guide our programming with opportunities for inquiry based learning.
- Our program supports and promotes the cultural diversity amongst our families. Families are encouraged to share their culture through our program.
- We have a wonderful outdoor learning environment that allows for free nature play as well as inquiry based learning opportunities. We have developed the yard space over a number of years and continue to build natural play spaces for our children.
- Bush kindy is offered in term 2/3. Regular walks take place to the local lions walking trail.
- Regular camp fires occur in term 2/3.
- Local excursions occur to Jallarah Aged Care the local school and within the community.
- We have a large playgroup which occurs on Wednesdays and is run by parent volunteers.
