We were very fortunate to receive some additional funding at the start of the year, to be used for any maintenance or building upgrades. Some of this money has been used to put in extra storage into the Preschool and storeroom. What a difference this has made in being able to keep things tidy and organised.

We are trialling the use of SeeSaw this year, starting this term with the children in the 4 year old program. We will use this to pop up reminders, snippets of learning happening in Preschool and to put up some photos of your children. As it is a trial we would appreciate your feedback on how you are finding SeeSaw. Please see a teacher if you have any questions or need help accessing SeeSaw.

Preschool reminders:

Preschool starts at 9am (8:50am at earliest) and finishes at 3pm.

Our staff ratios and set up times do not allow for us to have children on site before or after these times.

Connected Beginnings—Restorative Practice

Restorative Practice recognises that the ability to manage relationships is key to lifelong learning and wellbeing. It supports the capacity to build and maintain significant relationships at home, at work, and in the community. It encourages self-reflection, creates the space for people to be heard and challenges negative behaviour and its impact on others.

In Ceduna over 320 People have been trained in Restorative Practices with a focus on Agencies and Organisations, it is now a priority for Connected Beginnings to support parents, families and community members to participate in the 2 day training as an important step forward in inspiring our community members to be actively involved and be a lead in the journey.

In collaboration with the Ceduna Youth Hub, Crossways Lutheran School and Ceduna Area School provided a two day Restorative Practice Training in March which was facilitated by Kerrie Sellen, to build the knowledge and skills of emerging leaders identified by their respective schools. The training was positively received by all students and staff involved and discussions are now turning to how we can keep momentum and build excitement within the school communities.

Kerrie further facilitated a Day 1 Introduction into Restorative Practices training in April with a target audience of community members and families. We had parents/carers of the emerging leaders group participate in this training which allows the conversation of Restorative Practices continue into the family home and community. We will continue to support the implementation of Restorative Practices in the Ceduna and surrounding Communities as a way to build relationships and strengthen community connections as well as positively manage conflict and provide opportunities for community led decision making.


