4. Centre Based Staff

Staff Profile:

In 2022 Pimpala Kindergarten is a part-time site (due to a drop in enrolments) staffed by a 0.6 FTE Director, 0.6 FTE Teacher, 0.6 FTE ECW (inclusive of universal access).

Performance Management Program:

All staff members undertake a biannual performance development plan (PDP) review to support them to align their personal goals to that of the department's strategic directions with the aim of continuously improving the learning outcomes of our children.

Access to special support staff:

The department have a range of Student Support Services (SSS) staff that provides proactive, targeted and intensive intervention services to support the additional needs of learners.

Services include: Aboriginal Education, Behaviour support, Psychology, Social work, Special educator, and Speech pathology.

5. Centre Facilities

Buildings and grounds:

The kindergarten was opened in 2016. The kindergarten was formerly known as 'Morphett Vale Preschool Kindergarten', and was located down the road in Venning Street prior its re-location at the school site. The facilities and grounds are modern and spaceous. The fenceline of our outdoor area has been extended in preparation for the redevelopment of the outdoor learning area. The tender documents have been finalised and are awaiting submission.

Our centre has a sustainability focus and features: Solar panels, rainwater tanks which flush the toilets, worm farming, gardening and composting systems.

Capacity (per session):

We have a physical capacity for 44 children

Current enrolment cap of 30.

Centre Ownership:

Our centre is owned by the Department for Education

Access for children and staff with disabilities:

We have a wheelchair access parking space in our staff carpark. We have an access toilet as well as a wide cubicle stall in the children's bathroom area. One sink in the children's bathroom is fitted with a low-tone sviwel handle. Our outdoor area is primarily wheelchair accessible.
