TERM 2 CURRICULUM

This term is going to be packed full of amazing experiences for our young learners! We have decided to embark on an adventure as we become taste explorers through the *Eat a Rainbow* program.

Children will have opportunities to taste different fruits and vegetables while building resilience and confidence by giving things a try, even if they think they may not enjoy it.

Each week we will focus on a colour and provide a tasting platter for the children to trial while we talk about the amazing things that fruits and vegetables do for our bodies.

You will have found an information pamphlet in your pocket, this may give you some ideas about what you can do at home to support your child's learning through this program.

This term we will also start our trips to the community library for our kindy children. Last term we made library bags, each child designed their own, to prepare for these visits. We are very excited to use this as an opportunity to allow children autonomy around choosing books to borrow and become responsible for ensuring they are cared for and returned to the library.

SCHOOL TRANSITION PROGRAM

to school. The children really enjoyed exploring and meeting school staff.

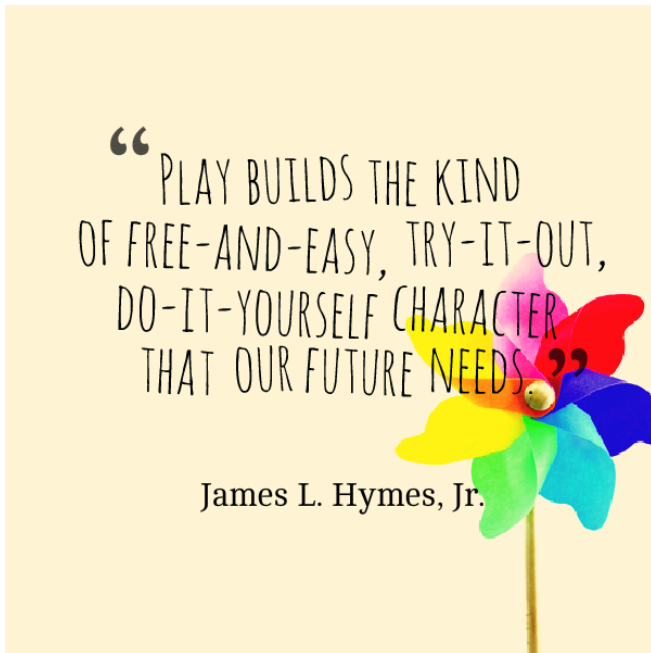
