Health and Safety

In the best interest of the health and safety of our children, educators and families please **DO NOT** send your child to kindergarten if they have a cough, cold, fever or show any signs of being unwell. If your child becomes unwell at kindy, we will contact you to collect your child as soon as possible.

Please contact the kindergarten by phone, email or Seesaw if your child is going to be absent.

Sunscreen

We are a Sun-Smart Centre and have agreed to follow the advice of the Cancer Council of SA . Please apply sunscreen to your child in the morning before kindergarten and staff will support children to reapply it again at lunch time.

Hats

In compliance with our sun safe policy, when the UV rays are 3 or above children are required to wear a hat for outside play. Please bring along a **named** legionnaire or full brim hat for your child. Kindy hats are available to purchase for a cost of \$10-00.

Don't forget to make sure your child has a hat in their bag everyday.

Lunch Boxes

Please remember to ask your child to place their **named** lunch box in the baskets under the verandah when you first arrive. We ask that you also place an ice brick in with the lunch to keep contents cool, especially on warmer days.

Healthy food is encouraged. Food such as chips, lollies & chocolate (even on or in muesli bars) and any other packaged food are not included in our healthy eating policy as they are high in fat and sugar. We are a "nut aware" kindergarten as some children and adults can have quite severe reactions to nut products. We thank you for your cooperation in helping us keep everyone safe.

Please also provide a named **water** bottle for your child. We will help children to refill their water bottle during the day if they need to do so.

Healthy Snack

Please keep your child's fruit in their bag for easy access at snack times.

Seesaw App

We will be sharing information and children's learning with families using the Seesaw app. You will receive notifications on your phone or computer when new items are added to your child's journal in Seesaw. You can also send messages, add comments to posts or provide feedback. Please speak with Susan or Sharon if you are having difficulty connecting to Seesaw.

Our Learning

We look forward to becoming a community of learners as we get to know the children and their families.

This term we will be learning about celebrations of culture such as Australia Day, the Lunar New Year, Shrove Tuesday and Easter. If your family celebrates any of these events, please speak with Staff about sharing your knowledge, skills and culture with the children.

We will also be focusing on building relationships and establishing a sense of belonging. Children will develop friendships and increase their social and emotional skills as they interact with others and engage in conversations during their play.

Our Kindergarten Site Priority is to increase and Council will be formed. extend children's understanding of number and quantification. Through songs, games and play based activities, children will further develop their counting skills and ability to name numerals and recognise quantities.
