Our Learning

The climbing equipment has provided opportunities for children to increase their gross motor skills. Gross motor skills use the large muscles in the body to allow for balance, coordination, reaction time and physical strength.

Children have become more confident to take on the new challenges to climb up and over the large frames, balance along the planks and swing on the disc swing and trapeze.

They negotiated the movement of the rope ladder to climb each rung to reach the top.

Social skills were also further developed as they waited for a turn, encouraged each other and shared in their achievements.
