
Winter is here and with it brings colds and flu. Please remember:

Kindergarten for 2024

In August we will begin offering families places for kindergarten in 2024. Children who have turned or will turn 4 years of age between November 1st 2023 and April 30th 2024 will be eligible to start kindergarten in Term 1 2024.

Outdoor Environment

During the holiday break work was carried out to complete the second stage in redeveloping our outdoor learning environment.

The watercourse has 2 water pumps, one to allow water to flow through the rocks along the curved pathway and the other filling the rock kitchen and digging patch. basin and trickling into the sandpit.





Children can sit on the bridge to watch the water as it travels under the bridge and it provides another entry point into the sandpit.



The watercourse will provide opportunities for children to increase their gross motor skills as they fill and carry buckets of water.

In the warmer weather children will enjoy the sensory experience as they walk bare foot along the pebbles and paddle in the cool water.
