### Reporting children's learning and progress

At Kindy, educators are continually reflecting on children's learning and planning new learning experiences to extend and stretch their thinking and learning.

At the end of each term, teachers write a **Statement of learning** for the term and a **plan for learning** for the new term - this plan is your child's individual learning plan/goals. Children attend Kindy for 23 days per term - this is if they attend all sessions and are not away for sickness or any other reason. This means that equivalent to every 23 days, you are receiving a report on your child's learning - that would be equal to a report every 5 weeks at school!

As well as the **Statement of Learning** at the end of each term, your child also receives other reporting which could be Magical Moments (Learning stories), reflections in their Kindy books or observations.

At the end of the year, your child will receive a full **Statement of Learning** which shows their strengths in literacy and numeracy as well their learning over the year. A copy of this Statement of learning is passed onto the school that your child will be attending in 2019 so that their class teacher can read it and see what your child's strengths and needs are.

Given the large number of children we have at Kindy and the limited time they attend, we do not offer formal "parent/teacher" interviews like at school. However, we are happy to make a time and have a chat with you if you feel you would like more information. Please speak to your child's main group teacher to arrange a time if this is the case.
