Welcome back to Kindy (or learning at home) for Term 2!

Firstly, we want to say thank you for being so understanding and supportive at the end of Term 1 - this year has turned out to be one like we've never experienced before and we are all learning how to navigate it together.

We are pleased that children are able to return to Kindy this term but also understand the choice made by some families to keep their child home for the time being. While children can come back, there are still restrictions in place which we need to abide by.

This includes not having families enter the site, no excursions or special events, no library visits and no cooking experiences at Kindy. We hope that these restrictions are lifted when it's safe, so that we can do some of the fantastic things we had planned at the beginning of the year.

We are required to report daily attendance so you need to let us know if your child is sick or away for any reason (apart from the families who have already told us that their child is learning from home). You can send an SMS to the Kindy mobile or phone us on the landline number.

COVID-19 measures

This term at Kindy these measures will be in place and we ask families to support us with these:

- If your child is sick, do not send them to Kindy - this includes even a slight snuffle, cough, etc (this advice has come from the Department for Health). Any child who displays symptoms of being unwell at Kindy will be sent home.
- In the situation of a confirmed case of COVID-19 at Kindy, there may be an immediate closure of the Kindy - this could even be during the day. It is very important that we have up to date contact details in case we need to contact you in a hurry. Please make sure you are contactable when your child is at Kindy.
- We have been instructed to not allow parents/carers onto the Kindy grounds. Staff will be signing children in and out each day to minimize the use of pens. Please remember to use social distancing when waiting outside the Kindy gate to drop off or pick up your child.
- Staff will take childrens' temperatures and help them wash their hands on arrival at Kindy.

If you know anyone that has a child who is eligible for Kindy next year, please ask them to come in and get an enrolment form if they haven't already. Forms need to be in by the end of June.

ENROL NOW IN PRESCHOOL

Going to preschool helps your child to learn new things, make friends and develop confidence.

Children who turn 4 before 1 May can start preschool at the beginning of the year before they start school.
