


## Mini Sports Day





The Wardu group used flints and steels to make some "5 minute fires". Teaching children how to safely and responsibly use fire in a supportive environment minimises the risk that they will experiment with fire in secret. The children used the Vaseline and cotton wool to help start the fire with the spark from the flint. It was very exciting!
