Centre Update from Catriona

Term 3 has created many avid listeners, storytellers and readers as the children have really enjoyed our weekly focus stories. Many families have participated in the Story a Day reading at home too and it was very pleasing to see lots of children bringing in their reading records to go into their learning journal. In our busy world sometimes it can be hard to make time for all those worthwhile activities however I really hope that you prioritise reading to your child at the top of your daily list. When a child sees and hears you reading to them daily they are becoming readers so enjoy the time and the many journeys books can take you on together.

Sunscreen is applied twice a day at kindy when the UV Index reaches 3 and above at 9.30 am. We apply sunscreen before fruit at approximately 10 am and 12 noon which gives us good coverage until 2.30 pm when we are usually back inside. When the UV index is reaching 3 at 9.00 am or earlier we ask that parents apply sunscreen on their child at home prior to arriving at

kindy. If your child has any allergies to the Coles 50+ sunscreen, please provide your own and give to a staff member who will store it with the sunscreens. Children MUST have HATS, we don't have spares so PLEASE check your child's bag before leaving home.

End of term clean-up. A big thank you to April, Matt, Jordan and Jake for helping with the end of term clean up.

Term 4 is only 9 weeks, it is busy and very fast paced. This is the term when children who start school in January start transition visiting their schools. We will also be having children visiting kindy who are starting in January 2024. If you have not received information from your child's school about these visits please call them this week. 
Stirling East Primary School transition visits are Tuesday 21 and Wednesday 22 November.


Crafers Primary School transition visits are Thursday 23 and 30 Nov and 7 December.


Please let me know if your child is attending another school and when their visits will be.

The winner was "We are going on a bear hunt!"


All children loved this story, we sang songs, danced, read, hunted and even had a teddy bears picnic! 28/09/2023








TEDDY BEARS PICNIC!


