Priority of Access

To ensure that there is equitable access to sessions for families when the demand for the Occasional Care service is high, the following children will be given priority to Occasional Care sessions

- Children not enrolled in another early years service.
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander
- Children with at least one parent not in the paid workforce.
- Children from low income families.
- Children with additional needs or at risk.
- Children of parent/s with a disability.
