



## Health and well being

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### Immunisation

We are required to copy your child's immunization records to ensure our systems are up to date in case outbreaks of certain virus are within the centre

### Injuries and illnesses

Minor injuries and illnesses are treated by the staff and you will be notified by an ALERT sticker on the sign in sheets. You will then be required to sign the accident register. Precautions against spreading colds, viral infections and contagious disease are very necessary at kindergarten, so parents please keep your child at home if he/she is showing any signs of any infections and contagious diseases as soon as they have been identified.

### Medication

For us to administer or apply medications we need paperwork completed and signed by your GP, we need the medication to be stored and labelled in a specific way. It is not appropriate to bring a sick child and their medication to Kindergarten without the appropriate forms being completed prior.

### Attendance

Attendance at preschool is not compulsory however, local schools, often give us feedback that those children who attend kindergarten are in a better position for making a successful start to school. You can choose to have your child attend all or some of their 15 hours per week.

What is vitally important is that attendance is regular and not a decision you make based on whims and tantrums. A sick child will find it difficult to enjoy their day and may be infectious to others. It is best that children who are not well or excessively tired do not attend until they are 100%.

Remember, attending kindy is your decision not your child's. If your child will not be attending a session we would appreciate you letting us know.
