Willsden Childhood Services Centre is an integrated Centre providing Preschool and funded Ocassional Care.

We are a stand-alone site and the preschool operates on a part time basis and caters for indigenous and non-indigenous children.

Willsden Primary school is the main feeder school and most of our children transition into that school. The first transition visits are supported by staff by both sites and have endeavored to strengthen our links with the school and staff.

We have a staff team that work well together and are focused on children's learning, focusing on literacy and numeracy, attendance and enrolments and the continuation of the Ocassional Care sessions.

We have continued to receive funding for Universal Access to enable children to access 15 hours of preschool within their eligible year.

We have a large indoor and outdoor learning space and over the next few years we will be focusing on improvements for the outdoor area.

Enrolments this year have steadily increased. Children attending the Preschool are from families representing a range of socio economic and cultural backgrounds. Around 80% enrolments are Aboriginal children.

The warranted staffing for this year consists of a Director, Teacher, ECW, Support Workers, and Ocassional Care worker.

The Ocassional Care program has been full to capacity. The families have been very happy with the service that we have offered. More children have continued on in the preschool program when leaving Ocassional Care.
