Safety at Kindy

We have been practising our Emergency Evacuation procedures at kindy this week. It is important to start the year of with this so that everyone (staff, visitors and children) are aware of their roles if we ever need to evacuate in an emergency.

Our front gates are an important part of ensuring the safety of all children at kindy and need to remain closed at all times. Please don't prop either of the front gates open when you arrive to collect children. We understand that we have a number of school children coming down now that we finish later in the afternoon and many are able to open the gates themselves- please pass this information on to them as well. We encourage these school children to come into the yard (it is much safer than waiting n the carpark) but to also respect our yard and the fact that the preschool children have packed everything up for the day and it needs to stay as they find it.

What have we been learning?

The Blue group have been following on the interests of children in the group (as recorded in our Discovery Book).

We have been exploring "science", following Henry's learning interest. We have been doing experiments, exploring energy, testing floating and sinking, exploring magnets, mixing potions, observing nature. We have tried to find the answer to our question "What is science." So far we think science is ~ pouring and popping, bubbles and popcorn, exploding, needing goggles, and cooking! A definition we have read says science is "Science is the process of learning about the natural world through observation and experimentation."

The Early Years Learning Outcome we have been covering is Outcome 4: Children Are Confident and Involved Learners ~ Children develop a range of learning and thinking skills and processes such as problem solving, inquiry, experimentation, hypothesising, researching and investigating.

The Green Group have been developing their sense of belonging as we connect with each other and work together. Our understanding of preschool routines and expectations is growing and, most importantly, we are forming respectful and trusting relationships with staff and each other

We have been practising many important social skills such as cooperating, negotiating, communicating, listening, sharing, turn-taking, helping, kindness and team work. We are learning to interact with others with care, empathy and respect.
